2012 Building Excellence Awards Eligibility Rules

- 1) To be eligible to participate in the 2012 Building Excellence Awards, your firm must be a member of the Kansas City Chapter, AGC.
- 2) All nominations must be received by **February 23, 2012**.
- 3) All nominations must be accompanied by a \$350 entry fee.
- 4) A contractor may make nominations in more than one category.
- 5) Projects must be completed between the two-year period beginning with the last Building Excellence Awards deadline for submission (February 26, 2010) and ending with the current deadline for submission (February 23, 2012).
- 6) Project(s) to be nominated may be physically located anywhere but they must have been constructed by a Kansas City Chapter, AGC member and managed from their permanent office in our geographic Kansas City Chapter, AGC jurisdiction.
- 7) A single project may be eligible to win in more than one category. Please note that a separate entry fee must accompany the Nomination Form for each category in which the project is entered.

This would apply, for example, to a renovation project being submitted for both Renovation Project of the Year and Project of the Year by a General Contractor. Please note that a separate entry fee must accompany the Nomination Form for each category in which the project is entered.

- 8) Separate projects may not be combined into a single entry, even if they have the same owner.

Note: Judging should be completed by March 8-9, 2012. The three Finalists will be notified prior to the Building Excellence Awards Ceremony on May 24, 2012. However, the Winners will not be known until the actual presentations at the Banquet and Awards Ceremony. Judging will be performed by neutral judges from various regions and disciplines.

The 2012 Kansas City Chapter, AGC Building Excellence Awards will once again recognize the excellence of our member companies in 9 categories:

- Project of the Year By a General Contractor/Construction Manager (in 5 size categories):
 - Over \$25 Million
 - \$10 to \$25 Million
 - \$5 to \$10 Million
 - \$1 to \$5 Million
 - Under \$1 Million
- Renovation Project of the Year by a General Contractor/Construction Manager
- Green Project of the Year by a General Contractor/Construction Manager
- Project of the Year by a Specialty Contractor
- Community Service Award
